The 12 books of Tirumurai represent the ancient legacy of Sivabhakti and Tamil music. The Ninth Tirumurai, composed by nine Nayanars, follows the musical tradition of the Tevaram Muvar.

It celebrates Lord Nataraja of Chidambaram, known as Koyil - the temple of temples – and several other shrines in 29 songs known as Tiruvisaippa

Nrithya Kalanidhi Bharatanatyam exponent the late Lakshmi Viswanathan grew up in Mylapore and was a regular visitor to the Kapaleeswarar temple. She was among the first artistes to incorporate Tevaram songs in Bharatanatyam

dance, combining the art, music and dance that flourished in the Chola period.

She was also a great litterateur, writing books and articles on the Devadasi tradition, poetry and dance.

The victim, Ashwath alias Soosai, of Srinivasapuram in Foreshore Estate, had several assault-related cases pending against him

Police said the attack took place around 4pm when Ashwath was riding a twowheeler near the temple. A three-member gang that trailed him intercepted his vehicle and attacked him with knives. After Ashwath collapsed on the road with deep injuries, passersby alerted police.

A team from the Mylapore police station rushed him to the Government Royapettah Hospital, where he was admitted in critical condition. He died on Monday

The case, initially registered as an attempt to murder, was altered to murder following his death. They also arrested Manikandan and Azharuddin in connection with the incident. A search is on for the third suspect.

Investigators said preliminary inquiries pointed to a long-standing rivalry between Ashwath and the gang over the past year. Police are examining CCTV footage from the area and analysing vehicle registration numbers of the two-wheelers used by the assailants to escape.

Tension prevailed in the neighborhood following the killing, as it came days after another youth, Mauli, was murdered in nearby Mandaveli.

Four men were arrested in that case. With two murders reported within 10 days under the Mylapore police limits, authorities have intensified surveillance and stepped up patrolling across the area.

Kauvery Hospitals' promoters to buy back 5% stake from Lightrock

Promoters of Sri Kauvery Medical Care (India) Ltd that runs Kauvery Hospitals, a leading multispecialty hospital chain in Tamil Nadu, are in advanced talks to buy back around 5 percent stake from existing investor Lightrock

The proposed transaction is expected to value the IPObound healthcare group at about Rs 5,000 Crores, the people said. It would mark a nearly 50 percent jump from Kauvery's last valuation of Rs 3,400 Crores in 2023 when IIFL AMC, part of 360 ONE, invested nearly \$70 million for about 16 percent stake.

The group is preparing for a public listing in the next two years at a targeted valuation of more than \$1 billion, sources said

Promoters currently own 47 percent of the company. while 360 ONE, GSK Velu, and London-based Lightrock hold the remainder.

Lightrock, formerly LGT Lightstone Aspada), which invested about Rs 140 Crores in 2019, holds about 11 percent stake in the hospital chain.

Kauvery operates a dozen hospitals—10 in Tamil Nadu and two in Bengaluru—with a total capacity of 2.355 beds. The group plans to add about 1,000 beds between FY25

and FY27, supported by a capex plan of Rs 580

Lightrock had held bilateral negotiations with multiple investors and received several offers. "The promoters are prepared to match the highest bid and take back the stake," one of the persons said.

The monetization move follows a leadership change at Lightrock's India arm in February. Samir Abhyankar, former BII executive and partner at TPG Growth, joined Lightrock as partner and head of India, replacing Kartik Srivatsa and Vaidhehi Ravindran, who stepped down from their India leadership roles.

Lightrock-advised funds have invested close to \$1 billion across more than 45 Indian companies, including logistics platform Porter, mobility-tech firm Chalo, lender Aye Finance, and ed-tech firm Scaler.

Founded in 1999 by Dr S. Chandrakumar, executive chairman, and Dr Manivannan, the Kauvery group has built its hospital chain through a clusterbased expansion strategy, primarily across Tier 1 and 2 cities in Tamil Nadu.

Its presence in Trichy, Hosur, Chennai, Salem and Tirunelveli spans for 10 hospitals with 1,933 beds,

with the two Bengaluru facilities adding 422 beds.

Kauvery reported a 38 percent year-on-year increase in consolidated operating revenue to Rs 1,344 Cores in FY24, driven by an improvement in average revenue per occupied bed (ARPOB) to Rs 32,188. The cardiology division accounted for 22 percent of revenue, followed by neuroscience, nephro-science, general medicine, and gastroscience, according to a recent India Ratings report.

India's healthcare delivery sector has been expanding rapidly, growing to Rs 6.3 Lakh Crores in FY24 from Rs 3.9 Lakh Crores in FY19, and is projected to reach Rs 9.4-9.8 Lakh Crores by FY28, per a Kotak Mahindra Group report.

Private hospital operators are significantly increasing bed capacity—particularly in Tier 2 and 3 markets—amid strong demand. Leading chains continue to post healthy occupancy levels even as average length of stay declines, reflecting rising operational efficiency.

Key financial metrics such as ARPOB and Ebitda per bed have strengthened on the back of higher patient volumes and improved cost control, the report added.

I am unable to focus on my business with the increasing stray cattle menace that pulls out all my vegetables and keep charging at my customers who are scared to come out. I am losing business and Chennai City Corporation is useless," says Vijayalakshmi a pavement vegetable vendor

They were seen eating the vegetables kept for sale near Solar House and the cattle owner was nowhere to be seen. These two horned animals keep charging at morning walkers and customers when they are chased out from the pavements by vendors using a stick.

"I normally go to buy vegetables as early as 6 AM so that I can buy fresh. Nowadays I am scared to go as recently a bull came charging at me and made me fall on the road losing balance. Added to the woe is the stray dogs' issue that is equally dangerous to morning shoppers," says M K Rangaraja Iyenger, 75, a retired State Government employee.

PETA brings "talking elephant" to school

Over 30 children of The Grove School, Alwarpet, watched in amazement as a spectacle unfolded before them: a six-foot-tall, lifelike elephant moving its head from side to side, raising its trunk, and blinking at

The animatronic 'talking' elephant Ellie is part of an empathy-building tour by the People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) India. It has n to Chennai and visited the school last week. The initiative aims to educate children about the cruelty faced by elephants, using the mechanical jumbo.

Unveiling the elephant – made of fiber and with a silicone trunk - at the school, Nandita Krishna, chairperson of The Grove School, said, "Ellie's presence will encourage thoughtful discussions on compassion and respect for all living beings. The children will learn about the cruelty faced by elephants."

Ellie comes with a back story: she is portrayed as a circus elephant that was separated from her mother at a young age. "We have seen elephants at temples and camps and have known that they were not treated well, but we were not aware of the extent of cruelty they endure. Ellie has helped us understand, deeply, the kinds of hardships they face," said Ananya, a Class 8 student at the school.

Pointing out that this exercise will foster empathy in children, the principal of the school S.M. Sujatha said that it will have a great impact on students in building compassion towards animals.

"Children naturally gravitate towards animals. Ellie, the animatronic elephant, helps children appreciate that animals experience emotions — pain, fear, joy, and love — just as humans do, and that they deserve to live freely and peacefully," said Meenakshi Narang, manager of Elementary Education at PETA India.

Since May 2023, Ellie has visited seven cities, spreading the message that elephants should not be used in circuses, rides, or other cruel practices. The lifelike elephant will remain in Chennai until December 19, visiting more than eight schools across the city, after which she will head to Nashik.

Jujube brings intimate, no-frills theatre back to Mylapore

Some performances draw you in with spectacle, but Jujube does it with simplicity. There was a time when evenings drifted by in verandas where people talked, laughed and lingered without hurry, and Jujube offers a small slice of that lost warmth as it unfolds in the leafy veranda of theatre patron Shreya Nagaraj Singh's Mylapore home. Directed by R Amarendran, it invites audiences to sit back, laugh a little and let curiosity lead the way.

Amarendran has always believed in the power of simplicity. When he began directing in 1992, he pushed against the elitist mould that defined Chennai's English theatre

He staged French plays at the Alliance Française so that students could practise their skills without worrying about cost or access. That spirit of no-

frills theatre continues to date, even with Jujube. The name itself reflects it. "The fruit is considered cheap and not important but it has a lot of nutritional value. So I chose this name deliberately," he says.

The evening will feature a selection of short comedies and possibly a reading. Expect bold humor, risqué punch lines and plenty of puns. "I used to watch plays by Sartre, Genet and Ionesco, which were cerebral, but I switched to comedies by Molière," he

His actors keep things sharp and conversational rather than theatrical. "My actors don't huff and puff and spout long dialogues or do a tirade on social evils. We don't want the audience to get stressed." He wants people to enjoy themselves without feeling weighed

What excites him most is the chance to break the

usual pattern of post-show silence. He hopes this gathering will open people up. "Many people don't even ask questions in the Q&A sessions. Maybe they are shy. But I am hoping to make them open up. This is what I am excited about," he shares.

The closeness of the veranda helps too. It creates an honesty that traditional stages sometimes dilute. "It is more intimate and the audience can see every nuance of the performers close up," he says.

True to his long-held philosophy, the event is free for a mature audience. When asked why this model still matters to him in today's theatre landscape, he says, "Theatre has given me confidence, endless hours of entertainment and lots of life lessons. This joy I want to share with others. For me theatre is not a fleeting fashion but a lifelong passion."




