CM inaugurates breakfast scheme for kids in Mylapore

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin inaugurated the expansion of the "Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme,' part of the flagship initiatives of the DMK government, to urban areas in the state.

Stalin, along with his Punjab counterpart Bhagwant Mann, served food to children at St Joseph's Primary School in Mylapore, marking the launch of the scheme. Mann took part in the event as the chief guest.

The expansion marks the 5th phase of the scheme's implementation, which is set to benefit 3.06 lakh more children belonging to 2,429 schools. With the fresh launch today, a total of 20.59 lakh children will benefit from the CM's Breakfast Scheme in the state.

The government said the dishes -- Pongal, kichdi, or Upma along with dhal and sambar-- are cooked at a centralized kitchen in a hygienic manner and transported to schools by vans. The breakfast scheme was

launched on September 15, 2022 by him after he learnt from his visit to a school that several children had not eaten anything in the morning, he said

In the first phase, 1, 14,095 children belonging to 545 schools were benefited and subsequently, over the years, the scheme was gradually expanded.

"After seeing the amazing results of the scheme and after evaluating its success, the scheme is extended to 3.06 lakh more children belonging to 2,429 schools in urban areas."

Now, the total number of children covered under the scheme is 20, 59,000 and they are studying in 37,416 government and state-aided schools.

The CM said: "They are entering the class rooms with energy after eating hot, tasty and nutritious food and the scheme is implemented at an annual outlay of Rs 600 Crores. I will not term this as expenditure. This is a superb

social investment. This is an investment that is going to bring unimaginable, manifold gains to the Tamil society in the future.'

He said he was closely monitoring the scheme's implementation and it has led to multi-fold improvements including development in the health of children and increase in attention and involvement in studies inside the classroom.

When both the parents go to work, they need not worry about preparing food for their children and their burden is reduced. They have peace that their children eat well in the school.

He further said: "From Dec 2023 to Dec 2025, in government schools, the health of children in government schools has improved. The incidence of visiting hospitals has reduced. Attendance has increased. There is improvement in learning skills. Nutrition deficiency has fallen and thus, there are several positive aspects and we have come to know all of this through studies.'

Certain states and some countries too were holding consultations to launch and implement the breakfast scheme and a developed economy like Canada has introduced the scheme. "It is a matter of pride that we are a model for them."

To the children, the CM said: "Eat well, learn well, play well; your life will be good. All the best." He recalled that Arvind Kejriwal, as the chief minister of Delhi, took part in the 'Pudhumai Penn' (Rs 1,000 monthly assistance for girls to pursue higher education) launch event in 2022 and now Mann has participated in another Tamil Nadu government event.

DR VASANTHI BADRINATH



Dr Vasanthi Badrinath, 85, wife of the late Dr SS Badrinath, founder of Sankara Nethralaya passed away in her

residence in Third Trust Cross Street, Mandaveli after a brief illness.

A well-known paediatrician and haematologist Dr Vasanthi was survived by two sons – Ananth Badrinath and Seshu Badrinath. Dr Vasanthi and Dr Badrinath met in Brooklyn in New York and married in 1967 before relocating to Chennai where they both dedicated their careers to advancing healthcare.

Dr Vasanthi supported Dr Badrinath's mission throughout his life and helped create a legacy of medical services and affordable care. She stood with him when he opened Sankara Nethralaya as per the wishes of His Holiness Jagadguru Shri Maha Periyava who dissuaded him from going back to the US.

She played a significant role in the success of Sankara Nethralaya working alongside Dr Badrinath to further the hospital's mission of delivering quality, affordable eye care and training the next generation of ophthalmic professionals and paramedical staff

Born on Dec 30, 1939, she also supported the development and expansion of Sankara Nethralaya through Sankara Nethralaya Women's Auxiliary that organized community and fund raising events.

Scholars affirm Agamas as divine counterpart to Vedas

Scholar at the national Agama seminar held at the National Sanskrit University (NSU), Tirupati stressed that the Agamas, much like the Vedas, are divinely revealed scriptures that give form to the divine in temples and guide rituals for the welfare of the world.

The two day event was

held last week. Speaking at the seminar, Dr Y Arunasundaram, Principal of Mylapore Sanskrit College, said the Vedas are not of human origin but revelations that mirror Indian culture

"Through the Agamas, the divine assumes form in consecrated idols, which symbolise the Supreme Being. Traditions such as

Vaikhanasa, Pancharatra, Shaiva, and Tantrasara are to be regarded as equivalent to the Vedas," he said, urging authentic research into Agamic principles.

Kuppa Shiva Subrahmanya Avadhani, Principal of the TTD Dharmagiri Veda Pathashala, underlined that while the Vedas form the root of dharma, the Agamas represent their application

"They encompass creation and dissolution, deity worship, meditation, yoga, and sacred rituals. The essence of all Agamas is the attainment of divine vision, with sacrifices, penances, and rituals serving as their extensions," he said

Presiding over the inaugural event, NSU Vice-Chancellor Prof GSR Krishna Murthy said the university was established to preserve scriptures such as the Agamas through publications, conferences, and workshops. "We are now preparing to establish an Agama exhibition hall," he announced.

SWD repairs, incomplete drainage create havoc

Commuting through Teynampet in the morning peak-hour traffic has always been a challenge, and the recent developments have made the task even more

Three factors have compounded the congestion - more barricades placed on the stretch from Anna Salai to KB Dasan Road for the flyover construction, incomplete drainage work on Eldams Road and storm water drain repairs in Alwarpet - with MTC buses and heavy vehicles diverted to service roads, the added load on the flyover has resulted in slow-moving traffic during rush hours.

"As new barricades have come up, the already narrow road has become even more congested, especially during peak hours. With MTC buses trying to turn at KB Dasan Road or Cenotaph Road, it has become unbearable," said a resident

At the Cenotaph Road junction, even pedestrians are struggling to cross the road. Lakshmi, a 65-yearold resident says earlier, the congestion was only till Nandanam, and after the signal, we were relieved. Now, traffic eases only after crossing the Cenotaph Road junction. The stretch towards Teynampet becomes too narrow near the junction, adding to the congestion.

Just adjacent to KB Dasan Road is the Eldams Road, one of Teynampet's busiest stretches, and is often packed even during nonpeak hours. Over the past week, traffic has worsened after the road near the Thiruvalluvar Salai junction was dug for underground drainage work. MTC buses trying to cross this section cause long tailbacks.

A source from the police department said the drainage work is over, but some small tasks remain. "Also, the concrete is still wet due to recent rains, so workers haven't closed it fully. Barricades have been placed, and a small path on the other side of the pit has been created for twowheelers," he said.

At Alwarpet, a section of the service road near Kauvery

Hospital junction up to Sriman Srinivasan Road has been blocked for storm water drain repairs. The flyover, usually one-way towards CP Ramasamy Road, has been made two-way to accommodate diverted traffic. This has led to slow-moving traffic on both sides during peak hours.

At the blocked section, vehicles are being diverted via Murray's Gate Road -Seshadri Road - Kasturi Rangan Road - Cathedral Road or Seshadri Road - JJ Road - TTK Road.

Krishnan a resident said earlier there used to be a queue of vehicles from CP Ramasamy Road as all vehicles had to take the service road to reach TTK Road. With the flyover becoming two-way, even though traffic moves slowly at times, it's a big relief.

A police source said the changes have been implemented alongside the storm water drain work, aimed at easing congestion or Anna Salai. The police are monitoring how the new traffic modifications are working, and continuing the two-way system on the flyover is under consideration
